Flea Market Rules and Information Union Thresheree – Last Full Weekend in July

Location: E6231 Hwy 22, Manawa, WI 54949

Directions: Enter the driveway by the cell tower, follow the gravel road, take the first left, and proceed on the gravel road to the Red Welcome Barn. Call Jacob Elsner once you reach the Barn: (920) 427-1408. He will assist you from there. **DO NOT USE THE RISKE ROAD ENTRANCE**

Set-up Times: Wednesday before the show, starting at **4:00 p.m.**

Thursday before the show, starting at **7:00 a.m.**

It is preferred that you set up on Wednesday and Thursday to prevent traffic backup

during the show.

Call the Coordinator to make other arrangements if necessary.

Space Size & Price: 20' Deep by 25' Wide/Frontage

Cost: \$40 per site + \$50 deposit per Vendor.

The fee is for all three days. If still set up at 2 p.m. on Sunday, deposit is returned

The vendor will receive two (2) wristbands for the weekend.

Additional wristbands are \$25 each (Friday, Saturday, & Sunday).

Please inform the Coordinator if your RV has slide-outs.

Generators are allowed to run until 11:00 p.m. Quiet time is 11 p.m.-6 a.m.

NOTE: There is NO electricity available.

Flea Market Rules & Regulations:

- No sales of items containing the Union Thresherman's Club logo.
- No sales of pornographic materials.
- No sales of weaponry to minors.
- Must have safety devices on all firearms.
- No sales of any ammunition.
- No political displays (i.e., flags, hate speech).
- Pets must be leashed or kenneled and under control. Owners MUST clean up after their pet(s).
 - Effective for 2026, there will be no pets allowed. Only ADA-compliant service animals will be allowed.
- Sales tax collection is the vendor's responsibility.
- When you leave the grounds, all trash must be picked up from your area.
- Vendors are allowed one (1) vehicle per site. All other vehicles must be kept in Spectator Parking.
- No vehicle traffic is allowed between the hours of 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Friday-Sunday.
 Registered handicapped vehicles, show officials, and emergency service personnel are exempt.
